On April 19, 2021, Shakil Hairston completed an assessment to determine the need for substance use treatment with Pathway to Care and Recovery Assessment Specialist, Amber Kirschner MS, NCC. This assessment process utilizes the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) criteria. The state of Pennsylvania has adopted the ASAM as their model of assessment. The Assessment Specialist invited Shakil to participate in an in-person interview. The interview seeks to collect information that will assist the Assessment Specialist in understanding Shakil's needs for recovery. From the information gathered in the interview, a determination is reached about the need for substance use treatment and the level of care that addresses those needs.

Assessment Specialist, Amber Kirschner MS, NCC, has concluded that Shakil Hairston meets the ASAM criteria of a 1.0 Outpatient Level of Care. This level of care provides treatment one day a week and one hour of skilled treatment services. Shakil is already partaking in outpatient at Mon Yough Community Services. He was informed that if he needs assistance finding additional treatment that he may reach out to Pathway to Care and Recovery.
